

Rothaus RiderMan 2017 - conditions of participation / rules

Eligibility requirements:

Women and Men of the age group 2002 and older are authorized to start. Both, members of sport associations as well as others can participate. License riders are allowed to start with a C-license only, decisive is the race day. Excluded from the participation are all licensed male riders of A/B class.

Registration fees 2017:

Registration up to and including February 28th, 2017:

Day starter individual time trial Friday: € 30,-

Day starter road race Sunday: € 40,-

Registration up to and including June 30th, 2017:

Rothaus RiderMan Tour (3 stages race): € 120,- (including Rothaus RiderMan shirt)

Day starter individual time trial Friday: € 35,-

Day starter road race Sunday: € 45,-

Registration up to and including September 22nd, 2017:

Rothaus RiderMan Tour (3 stages race): € 125,- (including Rothaus RiderMan shirt)

Day starter individual time trial Friday: € 40,-

Day starter road race Sunday: € 50,-

Registration:

Registration is possible online at www.riderman.de. A cancellation is possible until the end of the pre-registration period against payment of a cancellation and processing fee of 20%. A reimbursement of the registration fees in case of non-participation can't be claimed.

Late registrations are possible during the event weekend not later than one hour prior the respective start.

Competitions and age groups:

Rothaus RiderMan Tour and day starter:

1st stage & day starters: individual time trial
2nd stage (no day starters): road race
3rd stage & day starters: road race

Categories - both men / women:

Teens	2002 - 1999
RiderMen/Women	1998 - 1988
Masters I	1987 - 1978
Masters II	1977 - 1968
Masters III	1967 - 1958
Masters IV	1957 and older

In case of less than 6 starters in one category they will move to and be ranked in the next age category.

Standings:

Rothaus RiderMan Tour:

1. Day standing from the results of all starters (Tour- and day-starters)
2. Overall standing through addition of the times of all three stages (only Tour-starters!)
3. Mountain award standing through addition of the achieved points of all three stages (only Tour-starters!)

The Mountain standing covers several daily measurements and the first 4 riders receive 5, 3, 2 and 1 point.

Team standing German Cycling Cup – only at Rothaus RiderMan Tour:

A team consists of at least 4 and maximum 7 riders. The relation of sex and age of the team members is insignificant. The team standing at the Rothaus RiderMan Tour (overall standing after 3 stages) results of addition of the total time after 3 stages of the 4 best team members. A team standing is to be effected only at the Rothaus RiderMan Tour.

Time measurement:

The time measurement is carried out with a transponder which all participants receive at the accreditation. The return of the transponder is carried out directly at the finishing line. For the transponder not given back within 4 weeks the participant is billed for with 50, - EUR.

Special rules at the individual time trial:

To ride in the slip stream is not allowed and is punished with time suspension or with disqualification at repetition. The minimum distance must be 2 meters at least to the rider in front after overtaking. After 1 kilometer, the distance between the two drivers must be 25 meters.

Leader jerseys:

Participants of the three stages race at Rothaus RiderMan commit themselves to wear the leader jerseys made available by the organizer during the race (individual time trial and mountain standing). If the leader of the overall standing of the Rothaus RiderMan at the same time also should be the leader of the mountain standing, the 2nd placed rider of the mountain standing wears the leader jersey of the mountain standing. The leader jerseys of the Rothaus RiderMan in principle stand over the jerseys of the overall standing of the GCC and must be worn in every case.

Road blocking / observing the minimum speed:

Riders who can't adhere to the predefined minimum speed are taken by the race organizers from the race. The minimum speeds of the respective races must be taken from the detailed time tables. The instructions of the police and the race organizers strictly must be followed.

Bicycle / Equipment:

All two-wheeled bicycles equipped in faultless technical condition according the race rules of the Bund Deutscher Radfahrer e.V. are authorized. Wearing a helmet during the races is compulsory. The following bikes and equipments are excluded from the start due to safety reasons:

Trailers

Recumbent bikes and chair bikes

Hand bikes

Any handlebar extensions (except at the 1st stage/individual time trial)
Aluminum and glass bottles

Liability/declaration of consent/data release:

The participation in the competitions of the Rothaus RiderMan is carried out on the participants own risk. No liability for damages of any manner is taken by the organizer. This is both valid for persons- and for property damages particularly also for subsequent of accidents and for objects lost such as bicycles, accessories, clothing. With the registration, every participant explains obligatorily that there aren't physical doubts against his participation and he has a sufficient fitness level. The participant approves of the fact that he can be taken from the race if he exceeds the predefined time limits, violates against the race rules or when he runs the risk to damage himself physically. The participant agrees that the data of his registration form may be passed on and the pictures, shots and interviews in broadcast and television, taken about the event, advertisement, books and other media, may be published without any compensation.

The participant particularly confirms the correctness of all data indicated by him with the registration and assures that he doesn't pass his race number on to any other person and attaches it duly and well visibly. At registration for the Rothaus RiderMan Tour (3 stages race), the participants accept as well the conditions and rules for the participation in the German Cycling cup. The conditions and rule are visible under www.german-cycling-cup.de

Note acc. to Data Protection Act & Payment of the Organization fees:

The data of all participants are saved mechanically on the scale required for the execution of the cycle race. The registration is only regarded as obligatory when the registration fees are paid. This matures at registration and is immediately payable.
