

PROTECTION AND HYGIENE CONCEPT

Status of the concept: 17 August 2020

For the implementation of the Rothaus Bike Giro Hochschwarzwald, we have drawn up a catalogue of measures based on the specifications of the state of Baden-Württemberg in order to guarantee the safety and health of all participants in our event in the best possible way.

HEALTH DECLARATION

All participants and the members/volunteers of the organization must confirm in writing (see page 3!) that there was no contact with infected COVID-19 persons within the last 14 days before the event. Furthermore, it must be confirmed that there are no typical acute respiratory diseases (e.g. cough, sore throat, shortness of breath), fever, muscle pain or suddenly occurring anosmia or ageusia (loss of sense of smell or taste). Accompanying persons may also only travel if the above symptoms do not apply. Please check, if there are any restrictions from travelling from your country to Germany!

Contact Tracing:

All athletes, coaches and helpers must give their contact details to the organizer. Athletes are automatically registered in advance via the online registration. Coaches and relatives will receive the form in advance via all athletes to fill it and bring it to the accreditation desk on site. The form must be handed in when the starting documents are collected. In addition, forms will be available for filling out on site. Parents and relatives are also regarded as coaches. All contact data will be registered by the local organizer, are available to him and will be deleted automatically four weeks after the end of the event. No spectators are allowed in the start/finish area.

RIDERS DOCUMENTS / ACCREDITATION

The collection of the start numbers is carried out at the Nordic-Center Notschrei, Notschrei-Passhöhe 6, 79674 Todtnau. Teams or

groups are asked that only one person collects the starting documents in order to reduce the frequency. Moreover, on Thursday evening an additional time slot for accreditation will be set up (see timetable). The organizing staff will wear a mouth and nose protective mask and gloves. Access is generally only possible with a mouth and nose protective mask. A distance of 1.5 meters is to be kept wherever possible.

The final regulations will be available online at www.rothaus-bike-giro.de from 25 July 2020 and will also be sent by e-mail to all participants in good time before the event.

START PROCEDURE

The minimum distance of 1.5 meters and the general hygiene regulations apply in all event areas. Exceptions to this rule are the formation in the starting block and the race itself. All participants are only allowed to enter the starting area with mouth-and-nose-protective-masks. The mouth-and-nose-protective-mask has to be worn until the start. Please organize the mouth and nose protection yourself. Simple fabric masks, tubular cloths or buffs are sufficient.

The starting field is limited to a maximum of 500 starters and the starting procedure is spatially extended. Elite women and elite men as well as all age groups of the fun-category will start in a separate starting block. This division will be identical on all four race days.

ROUTE & FEED ZONES

The organization- staff wears masks and gloves at the feed-zones. The tables and utensils are cleaned and disinfected daily according to the hygiene regulations. In addition, hand-disinfectants will be available at the feed-zones for staff and participants.

FINISH / ARRIVAL AREA

There will be no animation program and no award ceremonies. All material prizes of the Fun-Categories will be sent free of shipping costs after the event respectively the prize money will be transferred to the elite. The final catering after the arrival at the finish line will be arranged with a gate and minimum distance. After the finish, the general distance rules must again be observed and the stay in the immediate finish area should only be as long as necessary.

SHOWERING

The showers in the specially installed shower container are open and a total of 10 individual cabins are available, which can be entered

from outside and individually. In the area around the shower container, a minimum distance of 1.5 meters must be maintained at all time. The showers are cleaned and disinfected daily. However, we recommend, wherever possible, that you shower in your own accommodation, e.g. hotels and holiday apartments.

GENERAL

The hygiene and distance regulations of the state of Baden-Württemberg must be followed throughout the event.
